




Positions

There are **5 players** on the floor at a time.

- Guards
 - Point Guard
 - Shooting Guard
- Forwards
 - Small Forward
 - Power Forward
- Center

Object of the Game

- The basketball court is a rectangle divided in two equal parts.
- Each team tries to score at a basket located in its frontcourt.
- Each team defends the basket located in its backcourt.



Start of Game

The game starts with a **jump ball** then alternate possession begins.



Traveling

- **Traveling** is having possession of the ball and moving without dribbling, results in a turnover.
